What is Open Source Software?

- Open Source software is software with source code that anyone can inspect, modify, and enhance.
- Source code is released under a license in which the copyright holder grants users the rights to study, change, and distribute the software to anyone and for any purpose.
 - Apache License 2.0
 - GNU General Public License (GPL)
 - MIT license
 - Mozilla Public License 2.0

Open Source Software - History

- If we have some good, it must be shared, 'A childhood learning'
- Richard Stallman started the GNU Project and founded the Free Software Foundation.
- Breakthrough innovation Linux

themselves-instead of simply operating it"


Open-Source Vs Closed Source

- From the humble beginnings of less than a dozen software engineers sharing code patches via email in February of 1995, to the incorporation of the ASF in June of 1999
